Project: Development and Building of the Tibetan Bridge across Via Dinarica, Gjakova Municipality

The cross-border project “Extension of Via Dinarica in the CBC Region Albania- Kosovo has started on 15 March 2018 and will end by 15 January 2021. The project is funded by the European Union Delegation to Albania through the IPA Cross Border Cooperation Programme with 85% of the total value of funds. The Community Development Fund-CDF is the Project coordinator while ADF is the partner.

Via Dinarica is 600km extension of recently established 310km long Via Dinarica in CB region of MNE and BiH (www.viadinarica.com), running east from Durmitor National Park (MNE) into Kosovo and Albania. Via Dinarica when completed will feature 2 long-distance trails, which represent uninterrupted physical activity related to two sectors - hiking and biking as the main tourist products.

By bringing Kosovo and Albania on board and comprising around 1000km through 4 countries, this mega trail will be a step towards the world’s must-do treks like the Via Alpine, Himalayas, Inca Trail or the Rockies, providing new opportunities on each side of the border.

The aim of this contract is development (full design & built concept) and building of the Tibetan Bridge Model in the Via Dinarica destination in Gjakova Municipality.

The Site visit is scheduled for **18.05.2021** at **10:00hrs**, in front of Municipality Building in Gjakovë/Gjakova and it is **mandatory**.
